

PART III - LISTENING

Example:

Female: Did you enjoy your birthday, Sarah?

Female: Great!

Number 3:

Female: I like this present.

Child: Yes, it was from Uncle Frank. They're funny socks – with monkeys on them! I don't know where he buys his presents - they're always very **4** ! I think I'm going to wear them to school tomorrow. They will make everyone laugh!

Female: Yes!

Female: Yes! This present is very nice, too.

Child: Yes, I love the pencil case. Anna gave it to me. It's the same colour as my backpack. Look, I've **5** put all my pens and pencils in it.

Female: Oh, yes.

Female: Oh, yes. And what did you get from your other friends?

Child: Michael gave me this lovely big sports bag. It's big enough to put my basketball in. I can put my **6** old bag in the bin! I'll take it to basketball today. I love all my presents – I've had a great birthday mum!

Example:

Woman: William, come and have some breakfast!

Child: But I want to finish reading my **7**

Woman: You're always reading about dinosaurs and **8** !

Child: No, this is a different magazine mum, it's about big spiders! It's really interesting!

Number 1:

Woman: They're dirty too. Here, take these **13** ones.

Woman: Now remember we need to go to the dentist after school today. We need to be there at 4:30 p.m. What time does football **14** finish?

Child: At 4 o'clock.

Woman: OK. I'll pick you up from school at 4:15. Don't be late!

Child: OK, mum.

Example:

Man: Hello, Emma. Would you like to colour this picture?

Child: Yes **15** ! The people are having a picnic, aren't they?

Man: Yes. What would you like to colour first?

Child: Umm. The woman's hair, I think.

Man: There are two **16** but one is wearing a skirt. Colour her hair.

Man: No, more colouring now. There's a boy who's standing **22** a tree. Can you see him?

Man: Last thing now. There are two babies on the picnic **25**

Child: Yes. Shall I colour the blanket?

Man: No, one of the babies is wearing a **26** hat. Colour it blue.

Child: OK. Is that all?
