A different kind of doctor

Dr Rizwan thinks he is very lucky to have this job. ⁵ ___ Luckily, my parents encouraged me to study medicine. If they hadn't, I wouldn't have been able to work here. I don't think I would have become an astronaut either – so this is the best of both worlds for me.'
