We use *have got* to talk about possession.

I've got (have got) the balloons.	I haven't got (have not got) the present.
He's got (has got) the key.	She hasn't got (has not got) a pizza.

Have they got food? Yes, they *have*. / No, they *haven't*.

Has Lena got a piano lesson? Yes, she *has*. / No, she *hasn't*.
