The Olympic Games are a big sports event. They take place every four years. There are two types of Olympic Games: the Summer Olympics and the Winter Olympics. In the Summer Olympics, athletes compete in sports like running, swimming, and basketball. In the Winter Olympics, athletes compete in sports like skiing, ice skating, and snowboarding.

The first Olympic Games were in Greece more than 2,000 years ago. Today, athletes from many countries participate in the Olympics. They compete to win gold, silver, or bronze medals.

The Olympic symbol is five colored rings: blue, yellow, black, green, and red. The rings represent people from five different parts of the world coming together to compete in the Games.
