REGULAR VERBS

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AFFIRMATIVE

Yes!

<Subject> + <verb>-ED ...

My brother **liked** pizza when I was a kid.

NEGATIVE

No!

<Subject> + didn't + <verb> ...

I **didn't like** pizza when I was a kid.

** DIDN'T es pasado, por eso el verbo ha de ir en infinitivo (presente) **



INTERROGATIVE

Did + <Subject> + <verb> ...

Did she **come** to your party last week?
