that: you talk about one thing, which is further away *Singular, fern*

these - those

these: you talk about more things, which are close *Plural, nah*

those: you talk about more things, which are further away *Plural, fern*



These socks on the floor.



Those trainers over there.

Thomas: Could you give me **that book** on the table over there, please?


Valentina: Do you mean **this book** here?
