that: you talk about one thing, which is further away

Singular, fern

This pullover here.



That jacket over there.



these - those

these: you talk about more things, which are close

Plural, nah

those: you talk about more things, which are further away

Plural, fern

These socks on the floor.



Those trainers over there.
