Present Simple information questions

We use question words – **how**, **who**, **what**, **why**, **where**, and **when** – in information questions. We answer these questions with information. With the verb *be*, the word order is **question word + be + subject**.

Who is Robert Walton? Victor's last friend.

With other verbs, we put an **auxiliary verb** before the subject.

How does Walton look at Victor? Sadly.

After the auxiliary **verb do/does + subject**, we use **infinitive without to**.

What do Walton and Victor talk about? Victor's life.
