on: on average, on purpose, on+day/date, go on vacation, on time

of: accuse of, guilty of

for: for+period of time, prepare for smth (but prepare **to V1**)

in: in broad daylight, in+month, in court

with: charged with, start with

No preposition: enter smth, answer the questions, go home, call sb etc.
