



Nike, Inc. (stylized as **NIKE**) is an American corporation which 1 (specjalizuje się w) _____ athletic footwear. It has a 2 (siedziba główna) _____ near Beaverton, Oregon, United States. It is the world's largest 3 (dostawca) _____ of athletic shoes and a major 4 (producent) _____ of sports equipment, with 5 (przychody) _____ in excess of US\$46 billion annually.

The company's 6 (założyciele) _____ were Bill Bowerman and Phil Knight. The company was founded on January 25, 1964, as "Blue Ribbon Sports" and officially became Nike, Inc. on May 30, 1971.

The company takes its name from Nike, the Greek goddess of victory. Nike markets its products under its own 7 (marka) _____, as well as Nike Golf, Nike Pro, Nike+, Nike Blazers, Air Force 1, Nike Dunk, Air Max, Foamposite, Nike Skateboarding, Nike CR7, and 8 (filie/oddziały/marki pochodne) _____ including Air Jordan and Converse.

In addition to manufacturing sportswear and equipment, the company operates 9 (detaliczne) _____ stores under the Niketown name. Nike sponsors many high-profile athletes and sports teams around the world, with the highly recognized trademarks of "Just Do It" and the Swoosh logo.
