

When adding and subtracting 4 digit numbers we usually round to the nearest 100.

$$4567 + 2212 = \quad 4547 - 2262 = \quad 4547 - 1942 =$$

$$4600 + \underline{\quad} = 6800 \quad 4500 - \underline{\quad} = 2200 \quad - \quad = \underline{\quad}$$

$$3727 + 2162 = \quad 6427 + 1932 = \quad 6651 - 2342 =$$

$$+ \quad = \quad + \quad = \quad - \quad = \underline{\quad}$$

When multiplying a 3 digit number by a 1 digit number we only round the 3 digit number to the nearest H

$$417 \times 5 = \quad 657 \times 5 = \quad 416 \times 4 =$$

$$\underline{\quad} \times 5 = \underline{\quad} \quad \times \quad = \quad \times \quad =$$

When dividing a 4 digit number by a single digit number we round to the nearest H that is the closest multiple of the number we are dividing by.

$$1332 / 4 = \quad 1847 / 5 = \quad 1747 / 5 =$$

$$\underline{\quad} / 4 = 300 \quad / \quad = 400 \quad / \quad =$$
