50 weeks, 50 states, 50 different jobs

When Daniel Seddiqui was 26, he travelled around the U.S.A for a year. He visited all 50 states and worked for a week in each one. He didn't use buses or planes – he travelled by car from job to job. He got money for every job he did but hotels were too expensive for him. He usually stayed in his boss's home, or with one of the other workers. 'People were very good to me,' says Daniel. 'They looked after me really well.'
