



Mudbrick Houses in the Sahel Region

In the Sahel region of Africa, the climate is hot and dry for most of the year. Because of this, the people living in the area have developed special homes to keep cool and protect themselves from the harsh environment. One of the key features of mudbrick houses in the Sahel is their adaptability. Over time, the walls may develop (8)____ due to the dry climate, but these can be easily repaired with more mud. This makes the houses durable and easy to maintain.

Outside the house, there is usually a small (9)____, where families grow vegetables and keep animals. This area is often enclosed by a low wall made of the same mudbrick material as the house, providing protection from the wind and animals.

The design of mudbrick houses reflects the needs of the people living in the Sahel. The combination of simple materials and practical design helps them survive in an environment where resources are scarce and the climate is unpredictable. Despite their simplicity, these homes offer (10)____ and comfort to the families who live in them.
