Plastic is made of components that can leach into whatever it comes in contact with.

ii) Use Canvas Bags Instead of Plastic:

Whether your state has banned the use of plastic bags in grocery stores, or you are trying to be more plastic-conscious, **reusable bags** are a great way to help the environment. Invest in some inexpensive canvas bags and use them while you're out running errands. Aside from being environmentally friendly – canvas bags are also much sturdier than both plastic and paper and will last you a lifetime if you look after **them**!

Cardboard boxes have become an integral part of modern life, used for everything from shipping packages to storing household items. While they are undoubtedly useful, it's important to consider their impact on the environment.

One of the biggest advantages of cardboard boxes is that they are made from a renewable resource: trees. Unlike plastic, which is made from non-renewable fossil fuels, cardboard can be recycled and reused multiple times, reducing waste and conserving natural resources. In fact, according to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the recycling rate for corrugated cardboard in the United States was 91.4% in 2018.

Cardboard boxes are also biodegradable, meaning they will eventually break down naturally in the environment. This is in stark contrast to plastic, which can take hundreds of years to decompose and often ends up in landfills or the ocean where it can harm wildlife.

However, it's important to note that the production of cardboard boxes still has an environmental impact. The process of manufacturing cardboard requires energy and water, and can **result in** air and water pollution. Additionally, the transportation of cardboard boxes contributes to greenhouse gas emissions.

Ultimately, the relationship between cardboard boxes and the environment is **complex**. While they have many environmental advantages over plastic, it's important to consider the entire lifecycle of cardboard boxes and work towards more sustainable practices.
