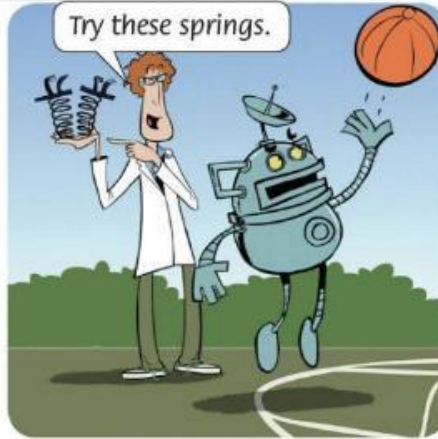
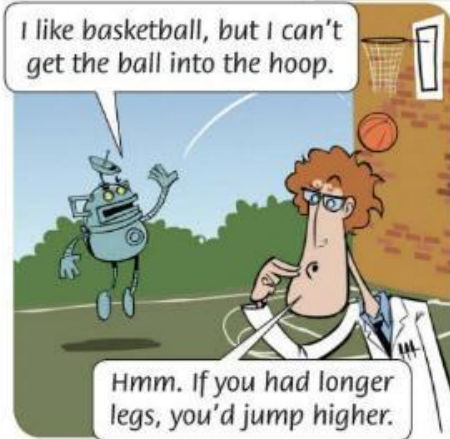

Second conditional

Use the **second conditional** to talk about things that are **unreal or unlikely to happen in the future**.

If I **had** a camera, I'd **take** a picture.

If I **had** longer legs, I **wouldn't** play so badly.

Look!

If you took a picture, I'd never speak to you again.

I'd never speak to you again **if** you took a picture.

Second conditional questions

Would you **play** rugby **if** you **lived** in England?

Yes, I **would**.

No, I **wouldn't**.

Look!

'd = would




wouldn't = would not
