Every child of a slave, from infant to teenager, also became the owner's property. Slaves performed many jobs, from cook to field hand to barber. Slavery caused great sorrow and pain, but it also gave rise to some of the world's most moving music. Spirituals are religious folk songs that began among slaves. They would sing these songs to help raise their spirits. Church gave them a place to express their hope for a better life to come. The choir made powerful music about that hope. Slavery ended for African Americans some 150 years ago. But spirituals remain an important part of life for many African Americans today. People of many races and backgrounds have come to appreciate spirituals. Many people also love blues music, which also originated from the African American experience of slavery. Many African American singers have released recordings of blues music and spirituals that have sold millions of copies all around the world.
