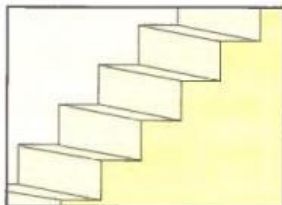

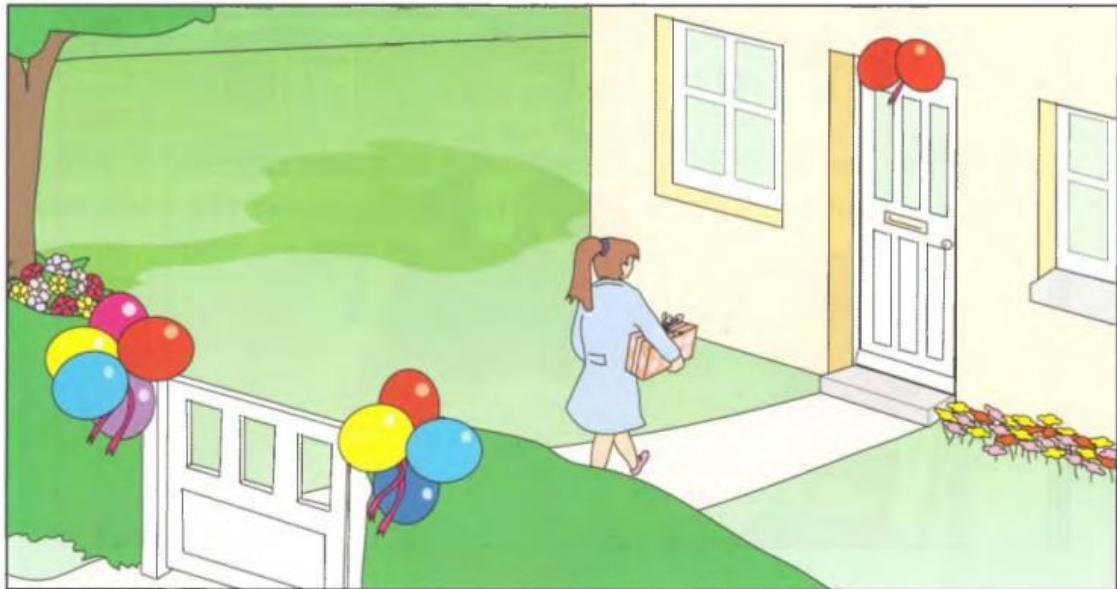

'Oh great! A CD! Thanks!' said Lucy.

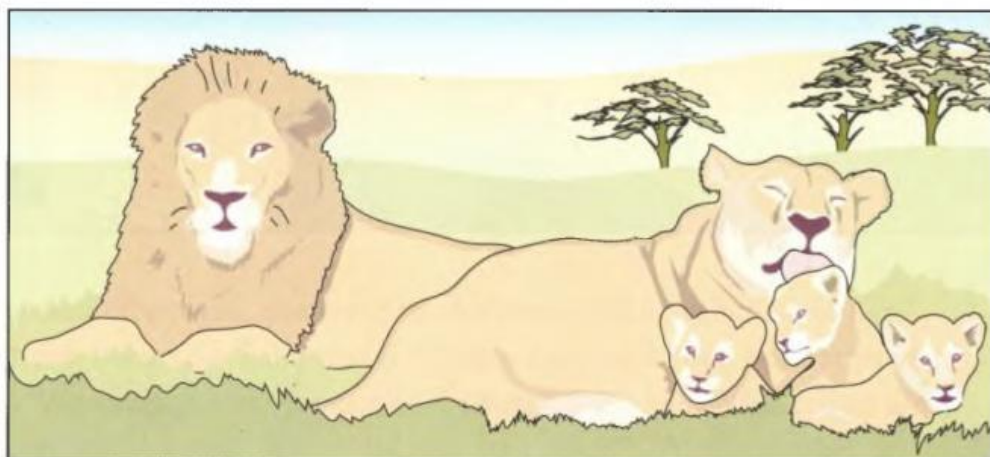
