1 ECUADOR IS A GREAT PLACE TO VISIT IF YOU LIKE NATURE AND HISTORY. EVEN THE BUSY CAPITAL CITY, QUITO, IS SURROUNDED BY MOUNTAINS. IN THE CITY, YOU CAN LEARN ABOUT HISTORY IN MUSEUMS OR ENJOY ONE OF THE CITY PARKS. OUTSIDE OF QUITO, YOU CAN TAKE A WALK IN THE WOODS OR GO UP TO THE TOP OF A MOUNTAIN BY CAR OR ON FOOT TO SEE THE WONDERFUL VIEW. THERE ARE MANY PLACES IN ECUADOR TO ENJOY NATURE AND LEARN ABOUT THE COUNTRY'S HISTORY.

2 ONE OF THE GREATEST THINGS ABOUT VISITING ECUADOR IS THAT YOU CAN EXPERIENCE THE WEATHER OF ALL FOUR SEASONS IN JUST A FEW DAYS. TO EXPERIENCE THIS, YOU HAVE TO GO TO DIFFERENT PLACES AROUND THE COUNTRY. QUITO HAS SPRING WEATHER ALL YEAR. IT'S WARM DURING THE DAY AND COOL AT NIGHT. IF YOU GO TO A BEACH ON THE COAST, IT'S HOT AND SUNNY —SUMMER WEATHER ALL YEAR! YOU COULD TRAVEL TO OTAVALO, A TOWN ABOUT 60 MILES (ABOUT 95 KILOMETERS) NORTH OF QUITO, TO ENJOY FALL WEATHER. THERE ARE MANY PLACES TO SPEND TIME OUTDOORS IN OTAVALO, SUCH AS POPULAR HIKING TRAILS TO WATERFALLS, VALLEYS, AND LAKES. YOU CAN ALSO VISIT THE OUTDOOR MARKET THERE, WHICH IS POPULAR WITH LOCALS AND TOURISTS. FINALLY, IF YOU WANT TO EXPERIENCE WINTER WEATHER IN ECUADOR, YOU SHOULD CLIMB COTOPAXI, A SNOW-COVERED MOUNTAIN.

3 ECUADOR IS HOME TO THREE CULTURAL UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITES: THE CITY OF QUITO, THE HISTORIC CENTER IN THE CITY OF CUENCA, AND QHAPAQ ÑAN. IN CUENCA AND QUITO, YOU CAN VISIT MANY MUSEUMS TO LEARN ABOUT ECUADOR'S HISTORY. QHAPAQ ÑAN, OR THE ANDEAN ROAD SYSTEM, IS AN OLD SYSTEM OF ROADS BUILT BY THE INCAS. THE ROADS THAT MAKE UP THIS SYSTEM ARE OVER 18,000 MILES LONG (ABOUT 29,000 KILOMETERS) ALL TOGETHER. THEY CONNECT THE TOPS OF THE ANDES MOUNTAINS AND PASS THROUGH SIX COUNTRIES IN SOUTH AMERICA. THESE HISTORIC HIGHWAYS ARE A POPULAR TOURIST DESTINATION, AND HUNDREDS OF PEOPLE WALK THE ROADS EVERY DAY.

4 ECUADOR IS ALSO HOME TO TWO NATURAL UNESCO WORD HERITAGE SITES: SANGAY NATIONAL PARK AND THE GALÁPAGOS ISLANDS. SANGAY HAS MANY INTERESTING ANIMALS, LIKE THE ADEAN CONDOR (A GIANT BIRD) AND THE TAPIR (AN ANIMAL SIMILAR IN SHAPE TO A PIG). PERHAPS THE MOST FAMOUS DESTINATION IN ECUADOR IS THE GALÁPAGOS ISLANDS. THERE ARE MANY UNIQUE ANIMALS ON THE ISLAND, LIKE THE GIANT TORTOISE AND THE LAND IGUANA. TOURISTS CAN SEE AN AMAZING VARIETY OF ANIMALS ON LAND AND IN THE WATER. THEY CAN LEARN ABOUT HISTORY, TOO. CHARLES DARWIN, THE FAMOUS ENGLISH SCIENTIST, VISITED THE ISLANDS IN 1835. VISITING THE GALÁPAGOS ISLANDS IS AN INCREDIBLE EXPERIENCE.

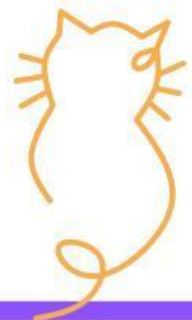

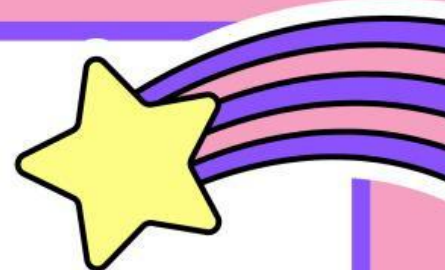

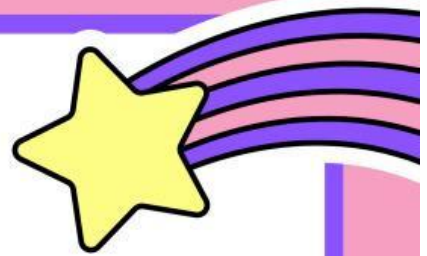
