'Breakfast is ready!' grandma says.

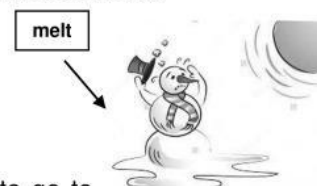
After some minutes the snow stops and the sun comes out.
