Yitzhak Rabin was born in Jerusalem on March 1, 1922. He was an Israeli politician and a general in the Israel Defense Force. He was Prime Minister of Israel from 1974 until 1977 and again from 1992 till 1995. In 1994, Yitzhak Rabin was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize, together with Shimon Peres and Yasser Arafat. All three got the prize for trying to make peace in the Middle East.

He died in Tel Aviv on November 4, 1995 after being assassinated by Yigal Amir, an Israeli Jew who was against Rabin's signing of the Oslo Accords and against making peace with the Palestinians. He was the first Israeli-born Prime Minister of Israel and the only Israeli Prime Minister to be killed. He was buried on Mount Herzl in Jerusalem.
