MAKING HEALTHY SALAD

- 2 cups of mixed greens (lettuce, spinach)
- 1 cup of cherry tomatoes, halved
- 1 cucumber, diced
- 1/2 cup of carrots, shredded
- 1/4 cup of olives
- 1/4 cup of feta cheese (optional)
- Olive oil
- Lemon juice
- Salt and pepper to taste

- Wash all the vegetables thoroughly.
- In a large bowl, combine the mixed greens, cherry tomatoes, cucumber, carrots, and olives.
- Drizzle olive oil and lemon juice over the salad.
- Sprinkle salt and pepper to taste.
- Toss the salad gently until all ingredients are mixed well.
- Serve immediately.
