Many of the world's biggest brand names had very humble (1) (BEGIN). The car manufacturer Porsche is no (2) (EXCEPT). Whether you are a fan of fast sports cars or not, reading about the (3) (GROW) of a small business into a large internationally renowned company makes for interesting reading.

This is the story of the company's rise to fame and covers eight decades and the book includes a wonderful (4) (COLLECT) of two hundred glossy photographs, including what is (5) (SURE) one of the most famous cars ever: the shiny Porsche 718 that will be forever associated with the (6) (LEGEND) actor James Dean, who famously crashed one in 1955.
