To answer student B's questions : Is 007 good at VB -ING ...?

Use the verb 'be' + adjective + at + BV-ING:

The adjectives are :

really bad/useless, not good, good, really good, amazing

Example : James Bond is **really bad** at listening.

007 is **amazing** at dancing.

007 is **good** at doing stunts.

To answer student A's questions : Can 007 + BV?

Use the modal 'can' / 'can't' / 'be able to' + BV + the following adverbs at the end of the sentence :

Not at all/badly, not well, well, really well, brilliantly/amazingly well

Example : James Bond can't dance at all.

James Bond can dance really well.

007 is able to dance well.
