

Conjugate each of the following verbs into both formal (usted) and informal (tú) command forms in Spanish. Be attentive to accents and spelling, as they will be counted for accuracy.

- For **informal (tú) affirmative commands**, For -ar verbs, the ending is -a (e.g., *hablar* → **habla**); for -er and -ir verbs, the ending is -e (e.g., *comer* → **come**, *vivir* → **vive**). However, some verbs have irregular affirmative tú forms, such as *ser* → **sé**, *tener* → **ten**, *hacer* → **haz**, and *ir* → **ve**.
- For **informal (tú) negative commands**, For -ar verbs, the ending changes to -es (e.g., *hablar* → **no hables**); for -er and -ir verbs, the ending changes to -as (e.g., *comer* → **no comas**, *vivir* → **no vivas**).
- For **formal (usted) commands**, For -ar verbs, the ending is -e (e.g., *hablar* → **hable**), and for -er and -ir verbs, the ending is -a (e.g., *comer* → **coma**, *vivir* → **viva**). For **formal (ustedes) commands**, the endings are the same as for the usted form, but in the plural form: -en for -ar verbs (e.g., *hablar* → **hablen**) and -an for -er and -ir verbs (e.g., *comer* → **coman**, *vivir* → **vivan**).

Write your answers clearly, and double-check for any accents or spelling variations. Good luck!
