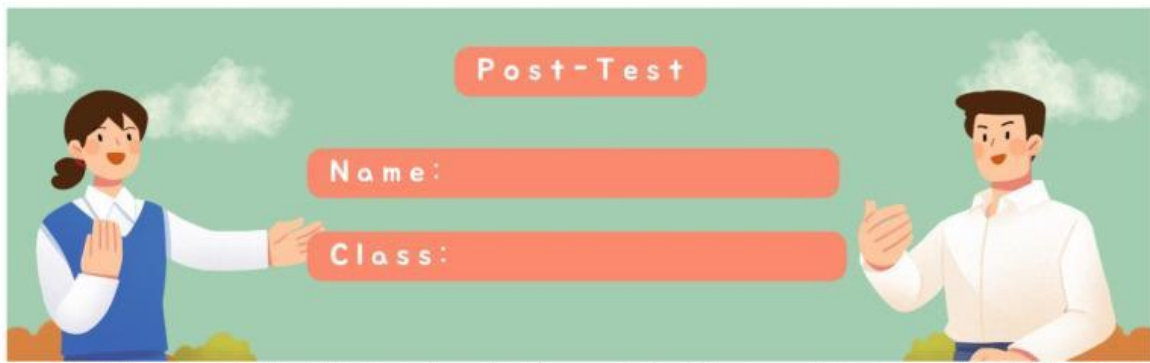




- **Read the texts below! Determine whether each text is a report text or a descriptive text.**

Text 1 =

The swan is a big, beautiful bird found in lakes and rivers. It has a long neck and white feathers, though some are black. Swans have orange beaks with black bases and dark eyes. They swim smoothly on water and eat plants and small animals. Swans live in pairs and protect their babies.



Text 2 =

The panda is a big, gentle animal with black and white fur. It has black circles around its eyes, giving it a cute look. Pandas mostly live in the forests of China, where they can find bamboo to eat. Bamboo is their main food, and they spend hours eating it every day. Pandas are quiet and like to rest often, making them calm animals.



Text 3 =

Spiders are small creatures found all over the world, in forests, deserts, and homes. They belong to the family *Araneidae*. Spiders eat insects, which they catch in their webs. There are over 45,000 species of spiders, with some, like the Black Widow (*Latrodectus mactans*), being dangerous to humans. There are billions of spiders worldwide, most spiders are harmless, but a few are endangered.



Text 4 =

Dolphins live in warm oceans and rivers around the world, including areas near North and South America, Africa, Asia, Australia, and Europe. They are very social animals and use sounds to talk to each other and find food. Dolphins eat fish, squid, and shellfish. The common dolphin is called *Delphinus delphis*. Some dolphin types are safe, but others are endangered due to pollution, fishing, and loss of their homes.
