Examples

1. Tom is short. Edward is short.

Both Tom and Edward are short.

2. Mukasa is a handsome boy. Wekoye is a handsome boy.

Both Mukasa and Wekoye are handsome boys.

3. My father is a doctor. My father is politician.

My father is both a doctor and a politician.
