The Training Program for Young Leaders, previously known as the Japan-ASEAN Youth Friendship Program, invites young individuals from developing countries to Japan to participate in activities across fields crucial to their nation's growth. The primary aim of this program is to develop human resources capable of taking on significant responsibilities for the future of their countries. Additionally, it provides an opportunity for the people and communities in Japan to foster international cooperation.

Since its implementation in Vietnam in 1995, the program has invited 1,249 young Vietnamese participants to Japan as of April 2007.
