Present Continuous: Questions

- ★ To make yes/no questions, we put the verb **be** before the subject.
- ★ To make wh-questions, we put the question words **what** or **where** before the verb **be**.

Yes/No Question		Am I	sleeping?	Yes, you are .	No, you aren't .
		Are you		Yes, I am .	No, I'm not .
		Is he		Yes, he is .	No, he isn't .
		Are they		Yes, they are .	No, they aren't .
Wh-question	What	are you is he	eating?	I'm eating a sandwich . He's eating fried chicken .	
	Where	are they is she	sleeping?	They're sleeping in their car . She's sleeping in her bed .
