This escape room can be completed in pairs, individually, or as a group.

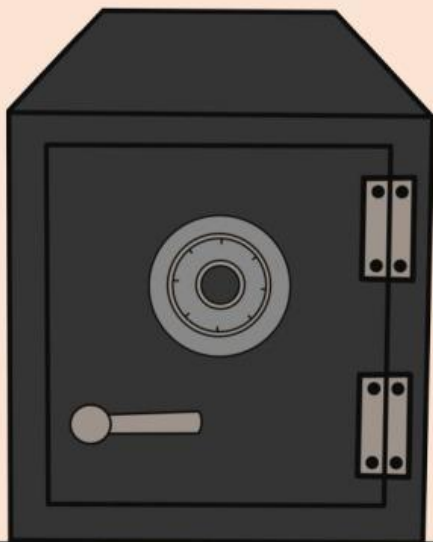
Procedure

- Talk students through the information on the PowerPoint, this should introduce students to the topic of Spreading Cultures in China and Southeast Asia. Hand out the first activity card to students and the answer sheet.
- Give students the instruction that they are trapped. Once they have completed the first clue card, you will then give students the answer code for that card to write on their answer sheet, and then give them the next clue card.
- After students have successfully completed all six of the task cards, they should have all six letters that spell out a word on their answer sheet.
- Teacher then get students to complete the plenary questions and discuss the answers as a class.
- Escape award can be handed out to student/students that completed the escape room the fastest!

Islam in China

It was believed that the first Islamic mission to China was in 627 CE, arriving at the port of Guangzhou, south of the Tang Dynasty court. The first Muslims to China settled there and built a mosque.

It was in 751 CE that Muslim armies went to Western China where they fought and defeated an army of the Tang Dynasty on the banks of the Talas River. This was known as the Battle of Talas.

2. _____

Islam spread to Java, Sumatra, Borneo, Malaysia, Indonesia and the Philippines. Not only did rulers become Muslims but common people also embraced the religion.
