"**Hay**" is an impersonal verb from "**haber**" used to indicate existence, meaning "**there is**" (singular) or "**there are**" (plural). It does not change with singular or plural nouns (e.g., Hay un libro / Hay libros). In the negative, it becomes "**no hay**" (e.g., No hay comida).
