

## LOCATIONS OF THE ICONIC LANDMARKS AROUND THE WORLD

### 1. The Eiffel Tower, France

from across the river  
on the left bank

is located in

The Eiffel Tower \_\_\_\_\_ the **7th arrondissement** of Paris, France, on the **Champ de Mars**, a large public park.
