Short Adjectives	Add -er + than to the adjective.	A rabbit is faster than a turtle.	Un conill és més ràpid que una tortuga.
Long Adjectives	Use more + adjective + than .	An elephant is more intelligent than a cat.	Un elefant és més intel·ligent que un gat.
