

The Day of the Dead

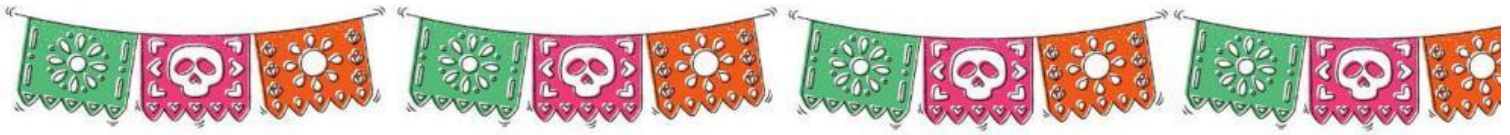
