He experienced betrayal. On the road to Golgotha, He was mocked, whipped and tortured. His body endured great suffering on the cross. Jesus endured to the very end.



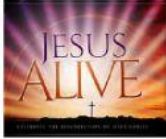
Suffering produces **faith**, **patience** and **endurance** in a person's life. When Christians suffer, they take part in the sufferings of **Jesus Christ**.

On the first day of the week Mary and Mary Magdalene went to the tomb taking spices to anoint Jesus' body.



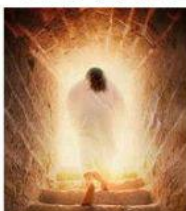
They found the stone rolled away; Christ was not there – He had risen like He had said.
