First Conditional

The first conditional refers to a possible condition and its probable result. These sentences are based on facts, and they are used to make statements about the real world, and about particular situations.

If you have a stomachache **If clause (Condition)** you will need to take an antacid. **Main clause (Result)**

In first conditional sentences, you can also use modals in the main clause instead of the future tense to express the degree of certainty.

If you have a cold, you can stay home.
