INTERROGATIVE / QUESTION

I / you / we / they (verb in base form) • You play the piano. • They brush their teeth.	DON'T I / you / we / they (verb in base form) • You don't play the piano. • They don't brush their teeth.	DO I / you / we / they (verb in base form) • Do you play piano? • Do they brush their teeth?.
He / she / it ↓ (add ' S ' to the verbs) • She plays the piano. • My dog eats burgers.. (add ' ES ' to the verbs that finish in; s, ss, o, x, sh, ch) • He goes to school • My dad watches T.V.	DOESN'T ↓ He / she / it (base form of the verb) • She doesn't play the piano. • My dog doesn't eat burgers. • He doesn't go to school • My dad doesn't watch T.V.	DOES ↓ He / she / it (base form of the verb) • Does she play the piano? • Does my dog eat burgers? • Does he go to school? • Does my dad watch T.V.?
