A Basic Recipe for Fried Rice

Ingredients:

- 2 large eggs
- 1 teaspoon salt
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 4 tablespoons cooking oil or as needed
- 3 cups cooked rice
- 1-2 tablespoons ligh soy sauce or oyster sauce as desired

Steps:

1. Lightly beat the eggs with salt and pepper.
2. Heat a wok and add 2 tablespoons of cooking oil. When the oil is hot, pour the eggs. Stir until it is lightly scrambled but not too dry. Remove the eggs and clean out the wok.
3. Add another 2 tablespoons of cooking oil. Add rice and stir-fry for a few minutes using a wooden spatula. Put soy sauce as desired.
4. Add the scrambled egg back into the pan. Mix thoroughly. Serve hot.
