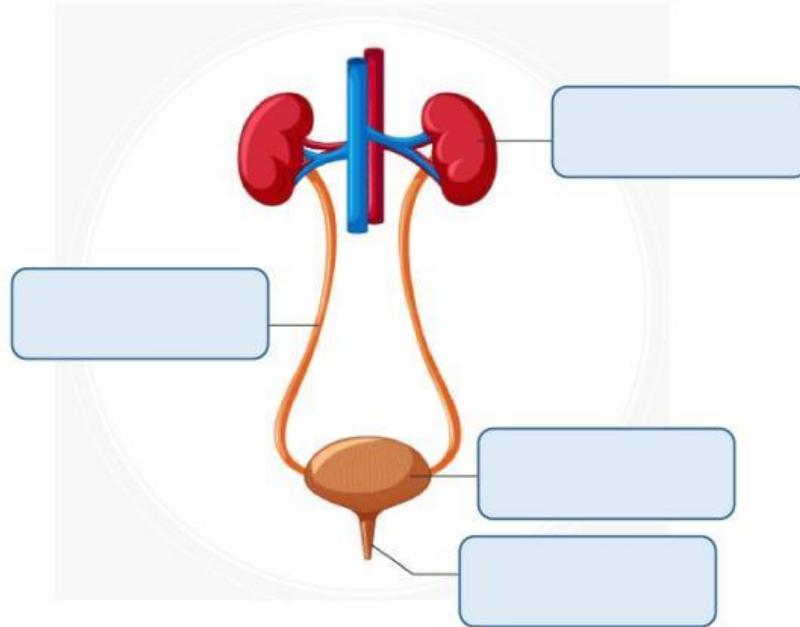


HUMAN BODY. EXCRETORY SYSTEM
