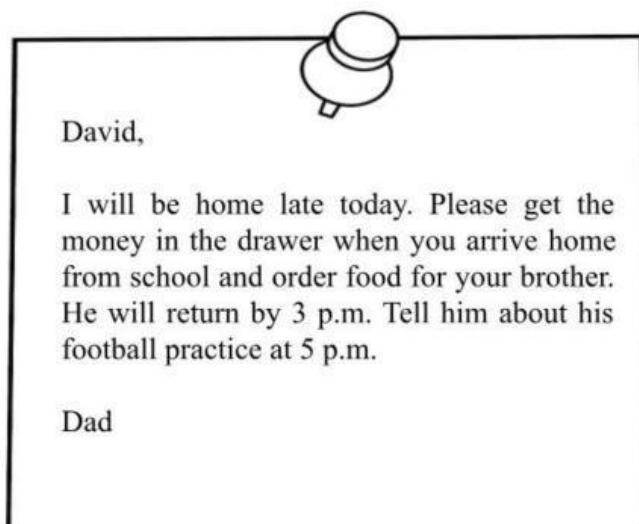

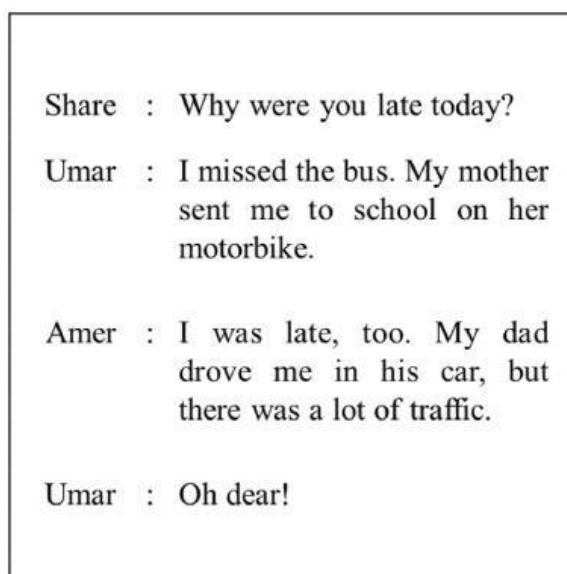

Keeping Your Home Safe

Your home is a safe place for you to rest and be with family. So, you should keep it safe. There are many ways to do that.

First, always lock the door at night. Make sure the windows are not open. This stops dangerous people from entering your home. Having a pet dog is sometimes helpful.

Second, be careful with what you post on the internet. Never give your address to people you don't know. They may be dangerous. If you are on a holiday, only share your photos with your friends if you post them online. If other people know that your home is empty, it may invite thieves.

You can also ask your neighbours for help. They can help to look after your home while you are away. You can bring back a present to thank them or offer to watch their home when they are not home.

Finally, you should be careful inside the house too. Put away knives and scissors so that you don't cut yourself by accident. Make sure that the stove is turned off after use and keep matches away from children. Doing so prevents fires from happening. Having a fire extinguisher in your house can help to stop small fires.
