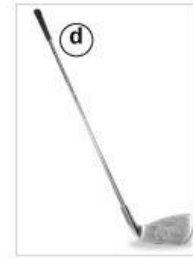

Contraste Present Simple / Present Continuous

- El Present Simple expresa hábitos, mientras que el Present Continuous indica lo que está ocurriendo en el momento de hablar.
*I usually **watch** a TV series, but today I'm **watching** a film.*
(Normalmente veo una serie de televisión, pero hoy estoy viendo una película.)
- Se suele usar el Present Simple para contar lo que ocurre en una historia o en una película.
*Then the hero **arrives** and **saves** the heroine.*
(Entonces llega el héroe y salva a la heroína.)
- El Present Continuous se suele usar para describir fotos, ya que se habla de la escena como si fuera algo que está ocurriendo en ese momento.
*In the picture, I **am riding** a horse.*
(En la fotografía, estoy montando a caballo.)
