How to Make Milk Tea

Ingredients:

- 1 cup of water
- 1 teaspoon of your favorited leaves
- ¾ cup of milk
- Sweetener of your choice

Tools:

- A small strainer
- A large tea mug
- A teaspoon
- A small saucepan
- A tea infuser

Directions:

- First, boil one cup of water in a small saucepan together with 1 teaspoon of your favorite tea leaves.
- Brew the tea for 2-5 minutes.
- Then, add $\frac{3}{4}$ cup of milk to the tea.
- Next, return the tea and milk to a boil and remove it immediately to prevent scalding the milk.
- Hold a small strainer over a large mug and strain the tea into the mug.
- Last, add sweetener if needed.

'Red Dracula' Tomato Soup

These are the ingredients you need:

- 2 ½ kg of very ripe tomatoes
- 2 medium onions
- 1 garlic clove
- 2 Oz of butter or margarine
- 3 to 4 tbs of all-purpose flour
- 4 tbs of tomato paste
- 4 cups of hot water
- 1 tsp of sugar
- 1 ½ tsp of salt
- 1 pinch of pepper
- 4 fresh basil leaves, torn into pieces.

The steps:

- Pour some boiling water over the tomatoes. After that, pour some cold water on them. This makes them pop out their skins easily.
- Skin the tomatoes, cut out the tops, discard the seeds and dice the flesh.
- Peel the onions and the garlic clove. Chop them finely.
- Heat the butter or margarine in a frying pan and saute' the chopped onion and garlic.
- Sprinkle with flour and stir in the tomato paste. While stirring, add hot water.
- Remove the frying pan from the heat and stir the mixture until the soup is smooth and there are no more lumps.
- Boil the soup again and add the diced tomato.
- Cover the soup and let it simmer for about 10 minutes on low heat.
- Add sugar and season with salt and pepper.
- Pour the soup into a bowl and decorate with a few basil leaves.
