Look at the picture and label it with the following words.

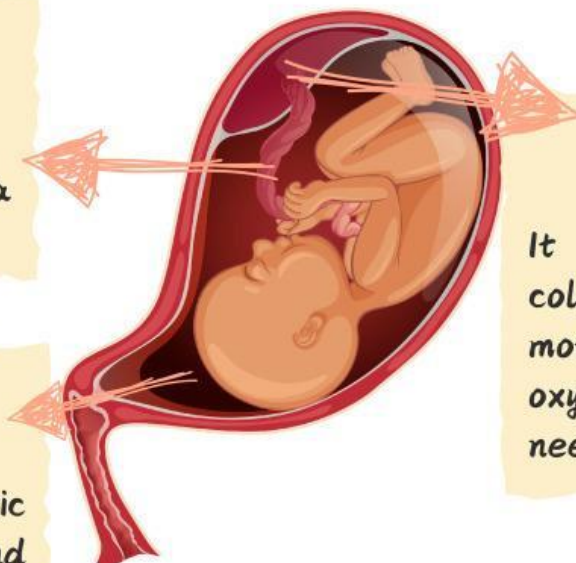
umbilical cord
