

## Activity 1: Listening and Writing

## ACTIVITY 2: READING AND SPEAKING

### **Text:**

### **Questions:**

1. Where did the family go last weekend?
2. What time did they arrive in the countryside?
3. What was the weather like during their trip?
4. What did they bring for their picnic?
5. What did the brother and the speaker do after lunch?
6. What did the parents do while the children swam?
7. Where did the family walk after their picnic?
8. Why did the speaker take many photos?
9. How did the family feel when they returned home?
10. What was the highlight of the day for the family?

**Objective:** Develop reading comprehension and oral communication skills by identifying irregular verbs in context and discussing answers with a partner.

## ACTIVITY 3: WRITING AND SPEAKING

**Instructions:** Write a short paragraph about a memorable day you experienced in the past. You must include at least 10 sentences using irregular verbs in the simple past tense. After writing, share your story with a partner and ask them questions about their experience. Answer any questions they ask about your story as well.

### Example Paragraph:

Last summer, I went to the zoo with my cousins. We saw many animals like lions, elephants, and giraffes. My uncle drove us there early in the morning. After arriving, we walked around and took pictures of the animals. At noon, we sat under a big tree and ate sandwiches. Later, my little cousin fell while running, but he was fine after we helped him. Before leaving, I bought a small souvenir from the gift shop. It was a day I will never forget.

### Steps:

- **Write your paragraph:** Think about a special day, such as a trip, a celebration, or a fun experience. Use at least 10 irregular verbs in the past tense.
- **Share your story:** Read your paragraph aloud to your partner and listen to their story.
- **Ask questions:** Ask your partner details about their story, such as:
  - Where did you go?
  - What did you do?
  - Who were you with?
- **Answer questions:** Respond to any questions your partner asks about your paragraph.
