DISORDER	CHARACTERISTICS
	a person has an extreme fear and distrust of others. They may think that someone is trying to harm them.
	a person prefers to be alone and is not interested in having relationships with others.
SCHIZOTYPAL	a person has unusual thoughts and ways of behaving and speaking. They are uncomfortable having close relationships with others.

CLUSTER B

17) _____ (drama) and 18) _____ (emotion) thoughts and behaviors that can keep changing:

DISORDER	CHARACTERISTICS
	a person has a long-term pattern of manipulating, exploiting, or violating the rights of others.
	a person has lots of trouble managing their emotions. This makes them impulsive and uncertain about how they see themselves.
	a person is dramatic, has strong emotions, and always wants attention from others.
	a person lacks empathy and wants to be admired by others. They think that they are better than others and that they deserve special treatment.

DISORDER	CHARACTERISTICS

	a person needs control and order. They are perfectionists and can be inflexible.
