**SAME**

Paul's new bike is exactly ..... mine.

Since he joined the gym he's been eating much more healthily.

**THAN**

His diet ..... before he joined the gym.

I had not expected to find learning English so interesting. **(IN)**

I am more ..... I had expected.

This is the strangest music I have ever heard. **(STRANGE)**

I have ..... music before.

She looks just like she did when I last met her. **(SAME)**

She looks exactly ..... when I last met her.

Getting tickets for the concert is harder than I thought. **(NOT)**

Getting tickets for the concert ..... I thought.

This website is easier to navigate than the previous one.

**HARD**

This website is ..... to navigate as the previous one.

What are some common structures used in these transformations?

It was a very bad idea to spend so much money on a new TV.

**SHOULD**

You ..... so much money on a new TV.

It's possible that certain species of butterfly will soon be extinct.

**MIGHT**

Certain species of butterfly ..... soon.

Why didn't you tell me what time we were meeting? (**SHOULD**)

You ..... me what time we were meeting.

When I started my speech I forgot everything I wanted to say. (**ANYTHING**)

When I started my speech I ..... I wanted to say.

Going home without saying goodbye wouldn't be right. (**OUGHT**)

I think we really ..... we leave.

Perhaps he missed the train this morning.

**MAY**

He .....the train this morning.

It's possible that she has injured her arm in the accident.

**HAVE**

She .....her arm in the accident.

It was a mistake for me to publish that photo in my blog

**PUBLISHED**

I ..... that photo in my blog
