It’s most famous for its three distinctive peaks, which form the shape of a ‘W’ and reach over 9,000 feet. If you’re lucky, you may get to see _____ guanaco, which is a native animal to _____ South America and closely related to _____ llama.

3 Ichkeul Lake and National Park, Tunisia

Ichkeul Lake and National Park is located in _____ north of Tunisia, in _____ Middle East, near _____ shore of _____ Mediterranean Sea. _____ Park is made up of a 511-metre-high mountain, expansive plains and _____ lake itself, which is a major stopover point for hundreds of migrating birds who come to feed
