Why are songs getting shorter?

Do you remember long instrumental introductions to pop ballads of the eighties? According to a study from Ohio State University, they ¹ four times shorter since that time. The reason is very trivial: it is the ² of digital technology. When we listen to a song on a streaming service, we can easily fast forward to the next song if we do not like what's playing. The scientists discovered that twenty-five years ago an average song introduction was about twenty seconds, whereas now it's only five seconds long. It is because young ³ today want to hear the lyrics as soon as possible. If the introduction takes too long, they skip the song and go to the next one. And if a song ⁴ for less than thirty seconds, it doesn't make money on a streaming service. Song producers didn't want to lose profits and, as a result, decided to cut the song beginnings.
