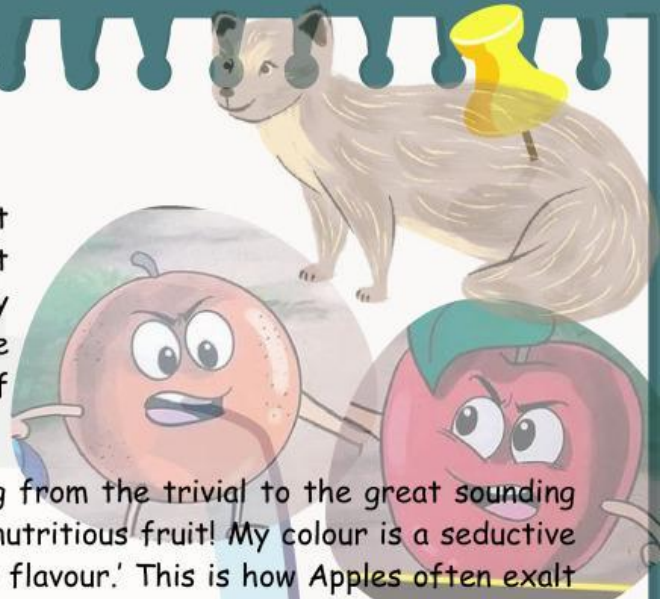
1. Read the text Carefully

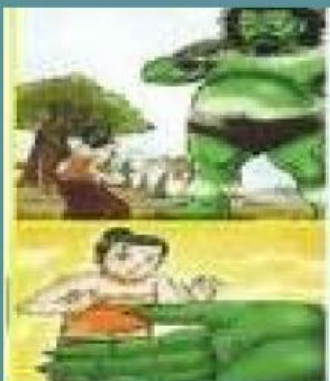
