

Infinitive is the «to» form, to smile, to dance, to walk and so on.

Present simple is what is happening **every day, normally, always, twice a week** and so on.

Present continuous is what is happening **right now, at the moment, this evening** and so on.

Past simple is what happened **yesterday, last week, three months ago** and so on.
