- a casual eatery where you can enjoy light meals, beverages, and desserts in a relaxed atmosphere.

Fine Dining Restaurant

- a casual restaurant, often characterized by its retro decor and a menu offering a variety of classic comfort foods.

Fast Food Restaurant

- a restaurant that prepares and serves pizzas, often with various toppings and styles.

Pizzeria

- an upscale establishment offering high-quality cuisine, impeccable service, and an elegant atmosphere.

Buffet

- a small, intimate place with a cozy ambiance and typically serving simple, hearty dishes.

Food Truck

- an eatery where you can quickly grab affordable, pre-prepared meals, often with a self-service model. (McDonald's, Burger King, and KFC are some examples.)




